Meet Conditions:

- 1. Age as at day of the meet, 12 October 2014
- 2. This meet will be conducted under SNZ rules and the local conditions listed.
- 3. No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
- 4. Entries \$6.50 per individual event
- 5. Late entries (\$12.00 per event) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane.
- 6. Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply
- 7. NO TIME entries will not be accepted. No time trials permitted.
- 8. Swimmers are required to meet the qualifying standard of at least one ASA Level 2 event.
- 9. Swimmers may enter either the 400 IM or the 400 Free, but not both.
- 10. Swimmers must <u>NOT have achieved an ASA level 1 qualifying time in any event.</u>
- 11. All events will be timed finals, with results declared for males and females in the following age groups: 10/under,11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over.
- 12. Reseeding or combining of heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
- 13. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- 14. Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers per session to a max of 6 unless requested for more before the meet. Please supply names with entries.
