- 'Over the top' starts and 'One Start' rule apply.
- All events graded scratch races. Results declared on times.
- Age Groups – 11/under, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16/over.
- **Swimmers may enter either 400 IM or 400 free not both.**
- Swimmers must meet a Level 1 qualifying time in at least 1 event.
- Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each age group, male and female.
