

Technical Training Seminars to be held in conjunction with ASL meets.

The ASA Technical Committee has decided to offer more opportunities for interested volunteers to participate in technical training seminars which are intended to lead toward qualification as IOTs, JOS, Starters and Referee's. These training seminars will be incorporated as a part of the Auckland Swimming League programme and will include some classroom instruction followed by practical observation and training. With large numbers of novice competitors participating, especially at junior league level, this provides an ideal opportunity in an unpressured environment to develop the technical skill necessary to train as a technical official.

The first of these sessions will coincide with the grading round of the ASL Junior League at Diocesan Pool on September 18th commencing at 1.30 and concluding at 5.30 pm - This will be ideal for already qualified timekeepers who wish to start work as IOT's, qualified IOT's who wish to upgrade their skills to become JOS, Starter's or Referee's. Subsequent seminars will be announced at a later date.
