- 1 Starter, National/Auckland qualified Starter
- 6 Inspectors of Turns
 - Generally 1 per 2 lanes, both ends - including a maximum of 2 trainees, Auckland qualified or better.
 - In 8 and 7 lane pools, 6 qualified IOTs & 2 trainees. In 6 & 5 lane pools, 4 qualified IOTs & 2 trainees
- 3 Timekeepers per lane with a minimum of 1 Auckland qualified or better TK for manual meets
- 2 Timekeepers per lane with a minimum of 1 Auckland qualified or better TK for electronic meets
